**10 Match Records**

Records for the last 10 Test Matches (prior to this one) played at Brisbane.

The captain winning the toss has chosen to bat twice. In total 4 matches have been won by the side batting first, 3 by the side fielding first and 3 matches have been drawn. The average first innings score is 380 - the highest being 585 (by Australia vs New Zealand, 18-21 Nov 2004) and the lowest being 82 (by West Indies vs Australia, 23-25 Nov 2000).

The highest fourth innings total to win a game was \*74-0 (by Australia vs Pakistan (5-9 Nov 1999), the highest fourth innings total was 296 by West Indies vs Australia (22-26 Nov 1996 - West Indies lost by 123 runs).

There have been 25 centuries scored (Australian 19, opposition 6). The leading century-makers are M.L.Hayden 4, R.T.Ponting 3. The leading run-scorers are R.T.Ponting 808 (62.15) & M.L.Hayden 792 (av 79.2). The highest individual score is 197 M.L.Hayden (Australia v England Nov 7-10 2002). Most wickets G.D. McGrath 50, S.K. Warne 34. Best innings bowling figures G.D. McGrath 6-17 (23-25 Nov 2000). Best match bowling figures G.D. McGrath 10-27 (23-25 Nov 2000).

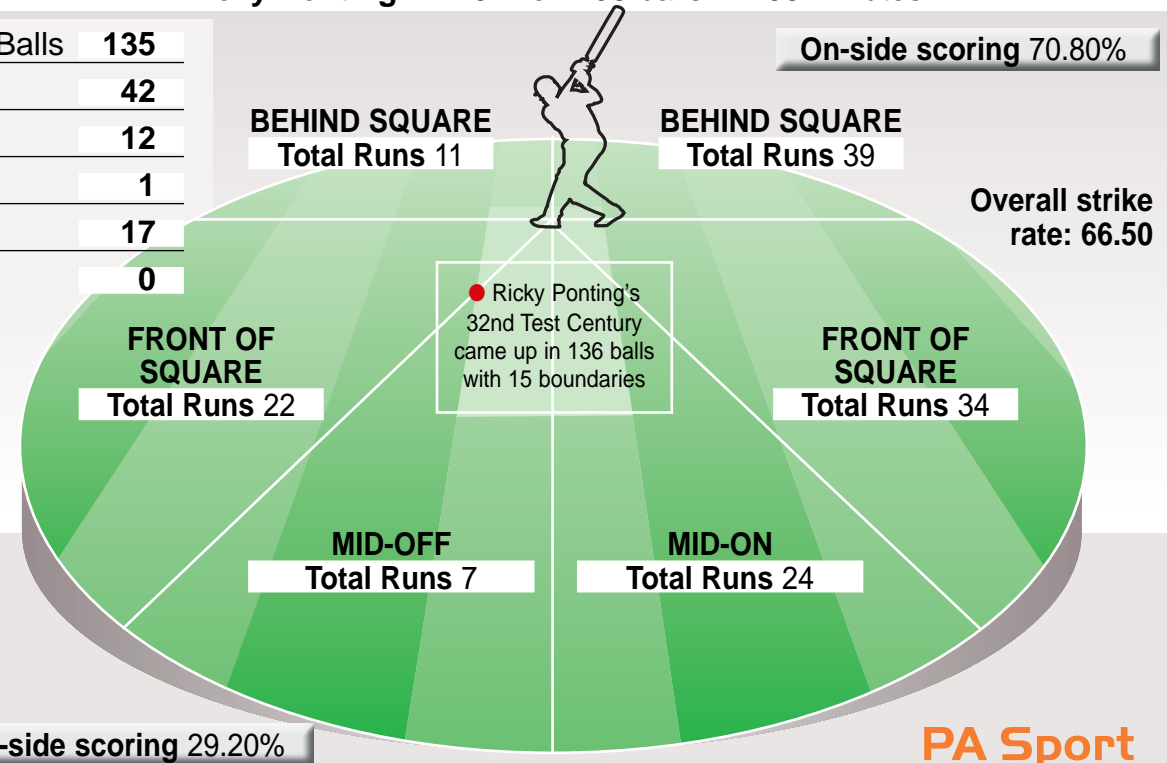
