Lancashire Cricket Board supported by Barclays Wealth and Chance to Shine, in conjunction with our partners Culture, Leisure & Sport at Blackburn with Darwen Borough Council are looking to appoint a full time Community Cricket Development Coach to operate in the borough of Blackburn with Darwen, working alongside cricket clubs and their local schools, with an emphasis on LCB Focus Clubs. The successful candidate will work closely with the Blackburn with Darwen Cricket Development Group and will be line managed by the Cricket Development Manager for North East and North West Lancashire. The post will commence in January 2009, initially for a fixed term of 3 years, with a view to extending the contract, subject to funding.

The post holder will focus on the coaching of young people in specific areas of Blackburn and Darwen. This will include coaching girls and boys, developing sustainable links between schools and Lancashire Cricket Board Focus Clubs. Involvement with the borough District Cricket Programme and local competitions will be expected. The main delivery will be in schools, clubs and other community settings. The post holder will also be required to assist with the administration of the Blackburn with Darwen Cricket Development Group.

Working hours will include some evenings and weekends, subject to the evolving coaching programmes and meetings.

Applicants must have experience of coaching cricket and young people, a knowledge of cricket development, be members of the ECB Coaches Association, have a valid driving licence, their own transport and will possess a minimum Level 2 cricket coaching qualification.

All applicants will need to possess:

- Excellent communication skills
- Excellent leadership skills
- Good IT skills
- Ability to work independently or as part of a team
- Ability to travel independently between sites
