3	Mitchell	1 and 2 3 4 5 6	Smith facing. No incident or score. Batsmen run 3. Umpire signals 1 short. Batsman hits and umpire signals Boundary six. No incident or score. Green is caught by wicket keeper. He is replaced by WHITE.
4	Thompson	1 2 3 and 4 5 6, 7 and 8	Smith facing. Batsmen run 2. Umpire signals No Ball and Bye. Batsman runs 1. No incident or score. Umpire signals Wide Ball and Boundary four. No incident or score.
5	Mitchell	1 2 3 4 5 6	Smith facing. Batsman hits and is caught by Jones after the batsmen cross. He is replaced by JOHNSON. No incident or score. Batsman runs 1. Umpire signals Bye. No incident or score. Batsmen run 3. No incident or score.
6	Thompson	1 2 3 4 5 & 6 7	Johnson facing. Umpire signals Wide Ball. Batsman is given out – stumped -by striker's end umpire. He is replaced by WILSON. No incident or score. Batsmen run 3. Batsman runs 1. Umpire signals Bye. No incident or score. Batsmen run 2.

7	Trueman	1 & 2 3 4 & 5 6	White facing. No incident or score. Batsmen run 3. Umpire signals Leg Bye. No incident or score. Batsmen run 2. Umpire signals Bye.
8	Burns	1 2 & 3 4 5 6	White facing. Batsman hits but is given Out – Run Out (Jones) at Striker's end attempting a second run after completing 1 run. He is replaced by WATSON. No incident or score. Batsman hits and umpire signals Boundary four. Batsman hits and umpire signals Boundary six. Kitchen injured in attempting the catch and is replaced by TOMPKINS. No incident or score.
9	Trueman	1 - 3 4 5 6	Wilson facing. No incident or score. Batsmen run 2. Umpire signals Leg Bye. Batsman hits and is caught by substitute fielder, after the batsmen have crossed. He is replaced by COLEMAN. No incident or score.
10	Burns	1 & 2 3 4 5 - 7	Coleman facing. No incident or score. Batsman hits and umpire signals Boundary six. Batsman hits and umpire signals No Ball and Boundary four. No incident or score. Batting captain declares the innings closed.
