The captain winning the toss has chosen to bat 6 times resulting in wins 0, draws 2, losses 4.

On the 4 occasions that the team winning the toss has elected to field first they have won 2, drawn 0 and lost 2.

The average 1st innings score is 317, the highest being 735/6 declared by Australia against Zimbabwe 9th-13th October 2003.

The lowest 1st innings score was 112 by England against Australia 28th - 30th November 1998.

The highest 4th innings total to in a game was 64/3 by Australia against England 28th -30th November 1998.

The highest 4th inns total was 381/7 against New Zealand 30th Nov - 4 December 2001 - match drawn.

There have been 15 Centuries. scored, 8 by Australians, 7 by opposition.

The leading century maker is J.L.Langer 2.

The leading run scorers J.L.Langer 663 & R.T.Ponting 638.
