Quantitative and Qualitative Detail.

Background.

The club used NatWest CricketForce as a delivery arm to carry out improvements to the facilities at the club. The showers were approximately 12 years old and in need of refurbishment as were the Ladies toilets and the bar serving area. The club had been given a dishwasher and were able to source second hand Parks style bench seating from the Local Health Authority who were replacing with new. Local pub company supplied new beer dispensing equipment.

Aims and Objectives.

1. Replace existing showers and refurbish shower area walls, floor and ceilings..
2. Refurbish Ladies toilets.
3. Refurbish Bar serving area.
4. Redesign kitchen to accommodate dishwasher.
5. Replace rotten door frame to Gents toilets.
6. Redecoration of clubhouse, kitchen, toilets and changing rooms
