The captain winning the toss has chosen to bat every time (10). In total 4 matches have been won by the side batting first, 5 by the side fielding first and 1 match was drawn.

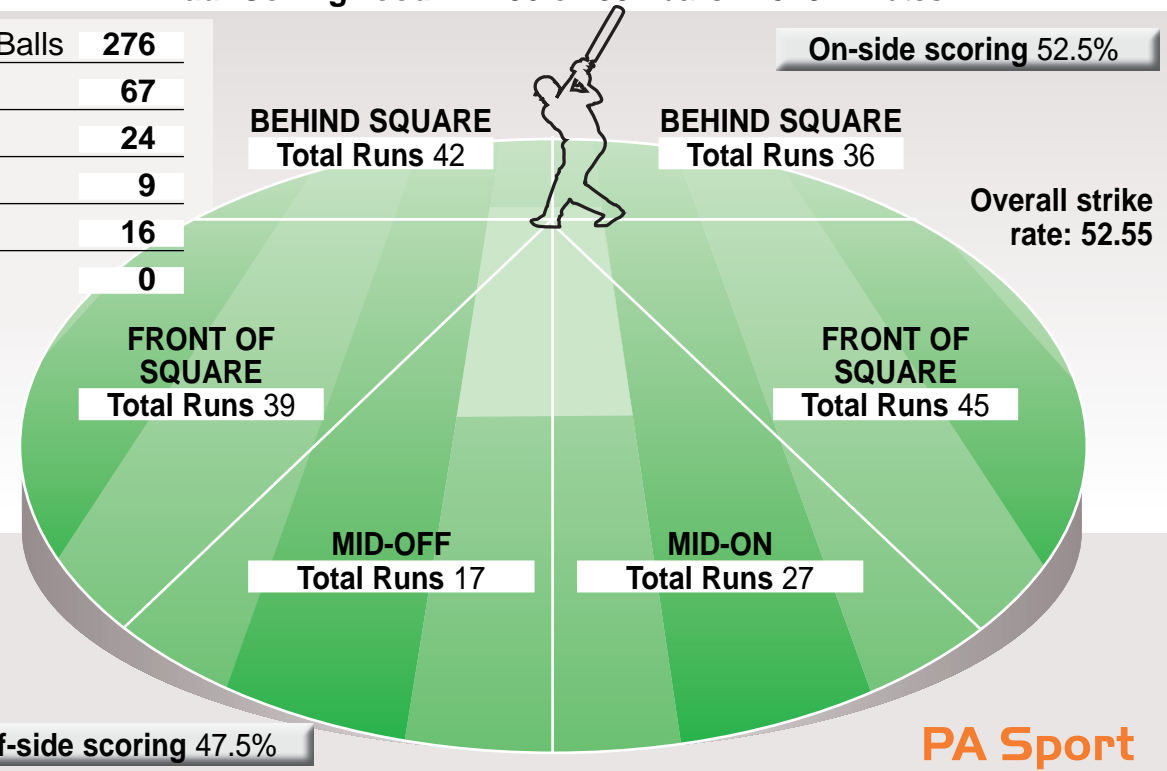

The highest 4th innings total to win a game was 233/6 (by India vs. Australia 12th - 16th December 2003), the highest 4th innings total was 250 (by New Zealand vs. Australia 26th - 30th November 2004) New Zealand lost by 213 runs.
